## CONFERENCE THEMES

The leading idea of the conference is environmental management. The environmental management should be understood as the performance of management functions in relation to the environment as a managed system and its individual components (air, water, soil, etc.). In other words, it is the management in which the subject is the environment. It is also management of usage, protection and shaping the environment.

Nowadays environmental management is construed as an interdisciplinary concept, integrating many aspects, among which the most important angles: environmental, legal, economic, technical and ethical, as well as aspects of responsible management may be included.

The aim of the conference is the integration of young researchers and practitioners working on the issues of sustainable development, to encourage people from different backgrounds to work together and create interdisciplinary teams engaged in research, related to the new paradigm of development.

The first Conference of the series "Contemporary conditions of environmental management" was held in November 2013. The conference was attended by a large number of participants, representing the scientific centers from Poland and from abroad.
